- Timeline for completion of project

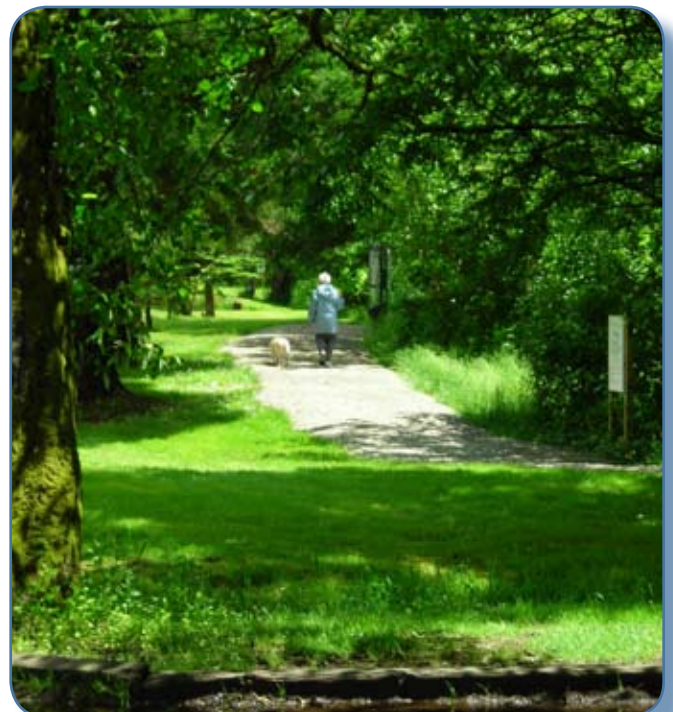
