Parks Foundation Receives Funding

Variety of Community Programs to Benefit from Local Philanthropy

VANCOUVER, Wash. – The Parks Foundation of Clark County is pleased to announce receipt of the following donations benefitting community programs:

1. A \$12,000 donation from John and Debra Bauman, owners of Bauman Chiropractic, will provide \$6,000 to the Vancouver-Clark Parks and Recreation Everybody Plays! Recreation Scholarship Program, specifically to provide free swim lessons for low-income youth, and \$6,000 to fund free family swim sessions at Marshall Community Center.
2. A \$10,000 donation from the Nutter Family Foundation through Dozer Day 2010 will provide \$5,000 in support of the Vancouver-Clark Parks and Recreation Access to Recreation Program and \$5,000 to the Vancouver-Clark Parks and Recreation Everybody Plays! Recreation Scholarship Program.
